Coupage of Grenache and Syrah varieties, which in elaboration follows a model of sustainable and ecological agriculture, without the intervention of chemical elements.

Porcelain protects BIO wines, since they require absolute darkness and stable temperatures for optimal conservation.

The edition is accompanied by a digital certificate of authenticity, NFT -Non Fungible Token-.

This gives added value and security to the owner of the wine bottle, since the NFT it's unforgeable, through the cybersecurity of this.

The design is a Homage to Maestro Amedeo Modigliani, based on his acclaimed sculptural work Tête on the centenary of his death in 1920.

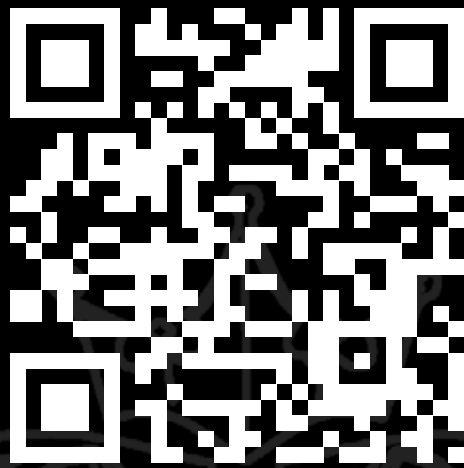
